BY LAW II

MEMBERS

Section One. Classes of Members

The association shall have two classes of members. The designation of such classes and the qualification and rights of such classes shall be as follows:

1. Regular Member: Those personnel assigned or attached to the USAF Marksmanship Center competitive shooting team between 1 Aug 1957 and 1 Oct 1969 as a permanent member. Those personnel assigned to a USAF competitive shooting team. (Example, east/west, comd, base) Those personnel assigned in support of a USAF competitive shooting team or who held/hold AFSC753XX.

4. Honorary Members: Those individuals elected by majority vote of the Board of Directors in the event that a members is to be conferred upon a deceased or terminally ill person section two of this By Laws shall be suspended and no fee shall be charged.

Section Two. Admission:

An applicant shall be admitted to membership in the association only on making application therefore and on being accepted by the Board Of Directors. Application for membership shall be in such form as shall be prescribed by the Board of Directors.

Section Three. Voting Rights:

Each member shall be entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote of the members. Honorary Members shall have no vote.

Section Four. Resignation:

Any member may resign by filling out a written resignation to the Secretary, but such resignation shall not relieve the member so resigning of the obligation to pay any dues, assessment, or other charges therefore accrued and unpaid.
